<p>Unit to initiate registrations for coaches and Boxers (<i>A minimum of <u>one</u> Level 2 Coach is required by unit in order to affiliate</i>) process to register as a coach, Boxer & Official is now Online via The EB Vault The online member registration is for Service Only and England Boxing applicants</p>	<p>Completed by Unit</p>

<p>Nominal roll of Boxers (Commanding Officers declaration form) This must be completed and then signed by the Unit CO <i>This is instead of Boxers registration forms</i></p>	<p>Completed by Unit</p>
<p>Coaches registration forms, Affiliation application, CO Declaration form and if registering as Service Only Payment for all registrations is to be sent to the Army Boxing registrar</p>	<p>Completed by Unit <i>Note – If registering as Service Only payment must be received in order to process the member application, Applications will not be approved until payment is received</i></p>
<p>Unit to book Boxers medicals</p>	<p>Completed by unit</p>
<p>Army Boxing registrar processes Coaches registrations and Unit Affiliation certificate (Certificate will be sent electronically to the unit Boxing Officer)</p>	<p>Completed by Army Boxing</p>
<p>Boxers BCR1 cards are partially completed by Army Boxing registrar, and then returned to the Unit Boxing Officer</p>	<p>Completed by Army Boxing <i>Note - The BCR1's must be taken with the boxer to their medical appointment for the MO to enter their medical data</i></p>

<p>Boxer attends Annual Medical with BCR1 – Annex B (Statement of Annual Medical Pass) is signed by Dr and Boxer, Dr is to also sign BCR1</p> <p><i>Dr signs page 5 (new applications) page 6 (renewal)</i></p>	<p>Completed by Boxer and MO</p>
<p>Boxers BCR1 and Annex B (Statement of Annual Medical Pass) is to be sent to the Army Boxing registrar to complete the Boxers registration</p>	<p>Completed by Unit</p>
<p>Army Boxing Registrar enters medical date onto the Boxers Vault application, and stamps the BCR1 for the season and attaches the Annual medical into the back of the BCR1</p> <p><i>Once completed BCR1's are returned by post back to the unit Boxing officer</i></p>	<p>Completed by Army Boxing</p>
<p>The registration process is now complete</p>
